Blurring – Phase 1

- Allows the selective blurring of regions of the video when making a clip
- Allows users to conceal the identity of selected people in the video
- Clips can be saved in native format

Save Clips as AVI

- The G4 viewer allows the user to save video in one of 3 formats:
 - o **AVI** – allows for play back of clips using windows media player - no special software is required to play back video as Windows Media Player is included in Microsoft's Windows Operating Systems.
 - o **Mini Player** – video clips are saved in a executable file that includes a "lite" version of the viewer. No special software is required to play back video as a player is packaged with the video. When the video is save with the mini player the user can save multiple video channels, view multiple video channels, view mapping, and display the status of sensors.
 - o **Native File Format** – video is saved in the native file format produced by the DVR. This is useful in some markets were a need exists to save video clips in their native file format.

Geographic Video Search

- o When GPS data has been included with the video the G4 Viewer will present a map to a user.
- o The map displays the track of the vehicle for the video that is loaded
- o The map will also display the current location of the vehicle and the path the vehicle has taken up to the currently playing point in the video.
- o When a user clicks on the tack of the vehicle the video will jump to the associated time when the vehicle was at the location.
- o If a user knows there was an incident (accident for example) at a specific intersection, by clicking on the vehicle track before the intersection the video will start playing from when vehicle was at that location.

Clip List

- o G4 Viewer presents a window that allows user to select a clip to play.
- o This is useful for customers who have experience with Gatekeeper's MaxView Viewer.
- o While G4 viewer allows users to jump to a specific point in the video based on time displayed on a time line, the clip lists allows users a second way to determine where to jump to in the video.
